Vioxx increased the risk of heart attack and stroke. Vioxx 25 mg or more per day have a risk of experiencing an acute myocardial infarction or an increased risk of myocardial infarction involving both short-term and long-term usage concluding that patients taking Vioxx for only a few months were also at risk.
